Podium Presentation Guidelines

Time limit: You will have a total of **8 minutes** to make an oral presentation

Do create a powerpoint presentation with the details of your research, and email it by

March 9th to neocore2023@gmail.com.

All presenters must bring their PowerPoint presentation on a USB drive as a backup and review their presentation at the computer available at the site at least **2 hours** before the start of the session. Staff will be available to help and signs will be posted onsite. **You will not be able to use your own laptop for the presentation.**

Your research will be evaluated on the basis of the following:

- Relevance of the topic and its uniqueness
- Objectives
- Methodology of the study
- Statistical analysis: Sample size calculation and Analysis of results
- Results
- Discussion
- Study strengths, limitations mentioned
- Quality of slides & References
- Quality of presentation

Time will be strictly adhered to. There will be a warning bell at the end of 7 minutes and the microphone will be switched off at the end of 8 minutes. There will be a period of 4 min for questions and discussion with the jury. We encourage you to practice your talk prior to the meeting with particular regard to the timing.

Poster Presentation Guidelines

All posters accepted for NeoCORE 2023 will be displayed in digital format, on high-resolution monitors. Your E-poster file must be sent to NeoCORE by **March 9th** (mail to neocore2023@gmail.com.)

Presenters are requested to be at their assigned monitors for presentation to jury at the pre-specified time (see Schedule).

A formal presentation for **3 min** will be followed by discussion with the jury for 2 minutes.

All presenters are to report at the registration desk one hour prior to the scheduled presentation. Staff will be available to help and signs will be posted onsite. Your monitor

assignments will be informed to you then. **You will not be able to use your own laptop for the presentation.**

CREATING AND DESIGNING YOUR E-POSTER

All posters will be set in landscape style orientation, ratio 16:9, (and all information i.e. text, data, photos, and figures) must be designed to appear within two slides.

Brevity and clarity are the essence of a good E-poster. Relevant images can be added to illustrate where appropriate.

Your poster will be evaluated on the basis of the following:

- Relevance of the topic and its uniqueness
- Objectives and Methodology of the study
- Statistical analysis
- Results
- Discussion
- Study strengths, limitations mentioned
- Quality of presentation
